About Law Day

Law Day is an annual event, which was originally conceived in 1957 when American Bar Association President Charles Rhynes envisioned a special national day to mark our commitment to the rule of law. The following year, President Dwight D. Eisenhower established the first Law Day. Law Day was made official in 1961 when Congress issued a joint resolution designating May 1 as the official date for celebrating Law Day.

About the Riverside County Law Library

The Riverside County Law Library is open to the public and provides free access to current legal materials, educational programs and professional staff to help with legal research. It is a County Special District effectively functioning as an independent public agency organized under the Business & Professions Code. Governed by a seven-member Board of Trustees made of community judges and attorneys, the law library is primarily funded from a small portion of the County's civil court filing fee.
