He plans to attend the virtual Internet Librarian conference in October.

E. Director's Report

A written report including a list of library programs, staff activities, library usage, collection, database usage statistics, and social media engagement for June was provided to the Board. Victoria stated that there is no Staff Monthly Briefing included in the report because June was a slow month and she was on vacation for half of the month. She mentioned that Lauren arranged a "Paint Party" on June 26 as a staff appreciation summer event which was enjoyed by all.

F. Acceptance of May 2025 Financial Report

IV. CLOSED SESSION


At 12:36 p.m. President Boyd announced that the meeting will go into closed session.


