Lawyers in the Library Call for Volunteers

In partnership with the Riverside County Library System (RCLS), a “Lawyers in the Library” program will be held at the Louis Robidoux, Sun City, Perris, and Home Gardens public libraries. The program, funded through a grant – “Project Connect NOW!” will start in September and continue through June 2022. Volunteer attorneys are needed to dedicate two hours per week to provide free 20-minute legal consultations via Zoom. We are seeking volunteers to join a team of 2 – 4 attorneys, with 2 alternates to serve as back-up. Time commitments can be broken down to 3-month increments.
