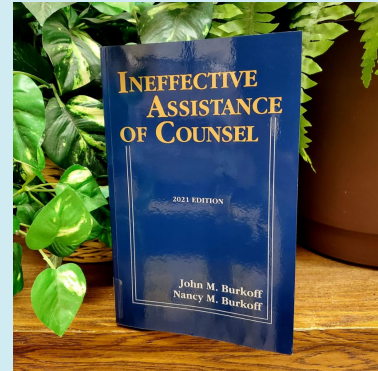

## Resource Spotlight

### Ineffective assistance of counsel John M. Burkoff, Nancy M. Burkoff

Ineffective assistance of counsel is the term of art used to describe a violation of a criminal defendant's constitutional right to effective assistance of counsel. This book discusses the development of ineffective assistance of counsel, evaluates the current state of the law, and provides a comprehensive source of guidance for those who encounter ineffective assistance claims in their professional work. This treatise is generally comprised of two parts: the first dealing with the development of the legal standards and the second focusing on the application of those standards by the court. The treatise goes through several cases that covers a lot of very specific circumstances that may come up in ineffective assistance of counsel claims and summarizes them in a way that is easy for anyone to understand.
